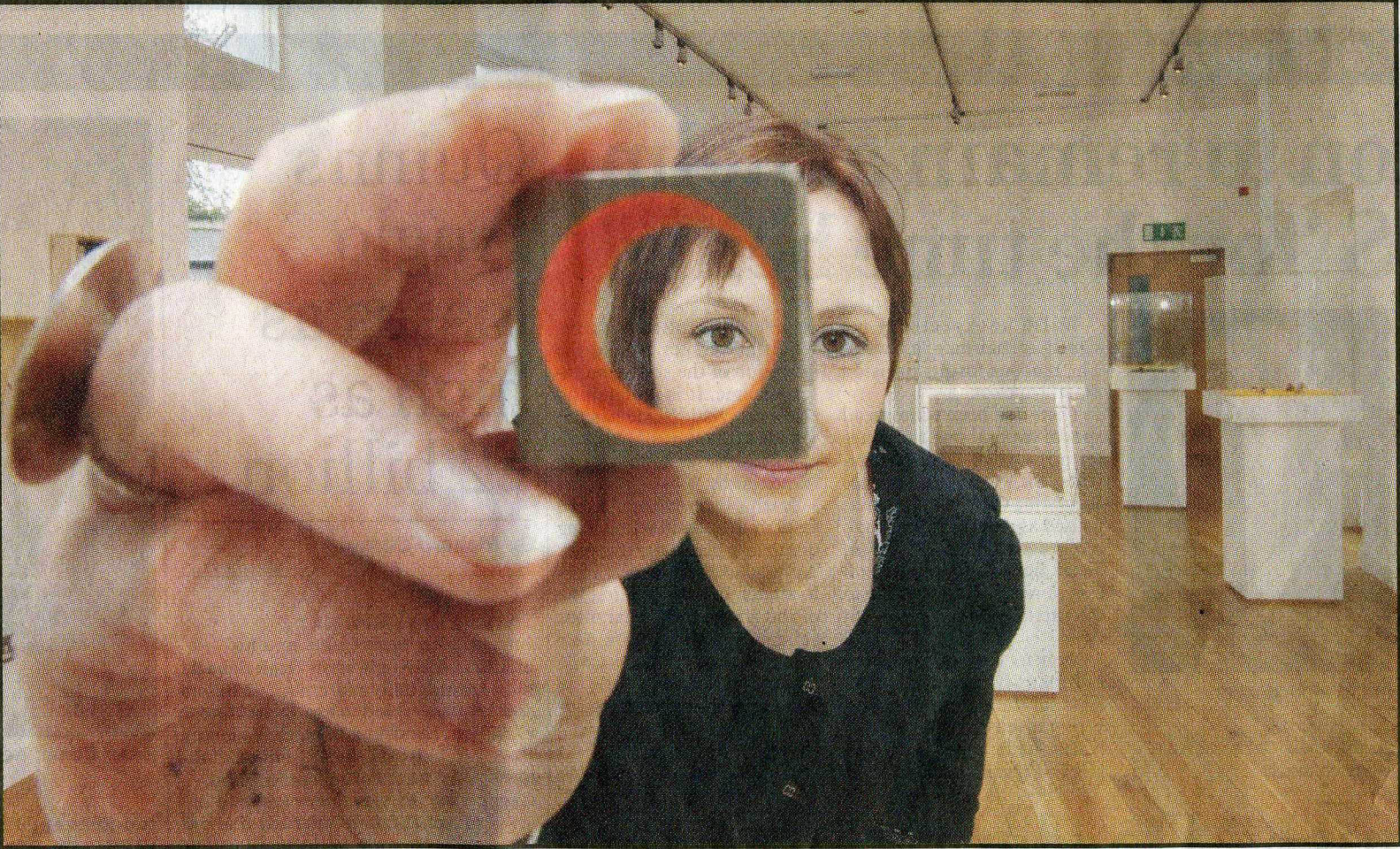


## Remembering with rings

An exhibition of 90 rings made by jewellery designers around the world has opened at the National Craft Gallery in Kilkenny. The rings were hand-crafted by individual designers – including a number of Irish designers – based on the theme of ‘remembering’.

The ‘Remember-Ring’ exhibition is on loan from Galerie Beeld & Aambeeld in Holland, and runs until April at the gallery in Castle Yard, the former stables of Kilkenny Castle.

Rings made by students in the Crafts Council of Ireland jewellery-making course are also on

display.
